


# TRAUMA CRITICAL FINDINGS

	<b>HEAD CT</b> INTRACRANIAL HEMORRHAGE MIDLINE SHIFT / MASS EFFECT / HERNIATION SKULL FRACTURE
	<b>C-SPINE CT</b> FRACTURE OR TRAUMATIC SUBLUXATION
	<b>CHEST CTA</b> AORTIC INJURY MEDIASTINAL HEMATOMA FRACTURE - STERNUM, T-SPINE PNEUMOTHORAX HEMOTHORAX HEMOPERICARDIUM
	<b>ABDOMEN CT</b> SOLID ORGAN INJURY (any type) FREE AIR GU INJURY (BLADDER/URETER RUPTURE) HEMOPERITONEUM FRACTURE - SPINE, PELVIS ANY CONTRAST EXTRAVASATION
	<b>EXTREMITY PLAIN FILMS:</b>  DISLOCATIONS CAN BE TIME CRITICAL FOR REDUCTION AND SHOULD BE REPORTED TO TRAUMA IN THE SETTING OF CODE YELLOW/ORANGE CASES. ISOLATED DISLOCATIONS ORDERED BY THE ER DOCS WITH NO OTHER FILMS DO NOT REQUIRE A PHONE CALL.

Options for making physician contact:

1. Contact trauma surgeon: 1-2814, or page "trauma surgeon on call"
2. Contact trauma midlevel: 1-2818
3. Contact the ordering ER physician or midlevel by calling the ER.
4. Use CONTACT REFERRING option in primordial palette.
