

ANY CONTRAST EXTRAVASATION

EXTREMITY PLAIN FILMS:

DISLOCATIONS CAN BE TIME CRITICAL FOR REDUCTION AND SHOULD BE REPORTED TO TRAUMA IN THE SETTING OF CODE YELLOW/ORANGE CASES. ISOLATED DISLOCATIONS ORDERED BY THE ER DOCS WITH NO OTHER FILMS DO NOT REQUIRE A PHONE CALL.

Options for making physician contact:

1. Contact trauma surgeon: 1-2814, or page "trauma surgeon on call"

2. Contact trauma midlevel: 1-2818

3. Contact the ordering ER physician or midlevel by calling the ER.

4. Use CONTACT REFERRING option in primordial palette.
