Using a worklist

A worklist is a set of exams that you designate for reading, reserved for you. You can select exams, or have the system assign exams automatically to your worklist.


The worklist helps you read exams efficiently and quickly. After you finish reading one exam, the system automatically presents the next exam on your worklist.

If you read for several facilities, the worklist organizes exams by each facility.

Manually adding exams to a worklist

- 1 Click the **Worklist** tab. Select one or multiple exams.
- 2 Click the **Add** button  The system moves the selected exams to your worklist.
- 3 Click the **Read Worklist** button. The system displays the Electronic Requisition and the images for the first exam.
- 4 When finished, click **Mark Read - Display Next Exam** button.





2 Keyboard shortcuts

Many keyboard shortcuts are built-in. To view a list of shortcuts when reading an exam:



In the Dominator menu, click **Help**.

Alpha keys

Tip: Press the key again to return to the previous state.

A	Display annotation or DICOM header information.	O	Show slice line on orthogonal images.
B	Display the barcode dialog box.	P	Play a prerecorded voice clip.
C	Display in Series-per-monitor mode. In mammography only: Display in Exam-per-monitor mode.	Alt+P	Display the Image Panel Properties.

Button	Name	Action
	Display Series in 3D	Launches the 3D viewer for the selected series.
	3D Cursor	Targets a specific anatomical area of an exam in the primary series, and in the same area in all displayed series.
	Apply Image Processing	Applies an edge enhancement algorithm.
	Arrow Annotation	Places an arrow on the image.
	Calibrate Image	Displays pixels per millimeter calculated from a line drawn over the image.
	Cardiac Measurement Annotation	Displays cardiac measurements.
	Cine	<i>In Series-per-Square mode only.</i> Shows the images in a continuous loop.
	Choose Worklist Exam	Opens the worklist to select another exam.
	Crop	Saves the selected portion of the image, and removes the rest of the image. Not available in Web Ambassador.
	Cross-reference Scout	Creates a scout inset in a series.
	Delete	Deletes the image. Not available in Web Ambassador and Web Dominator.
	End Exam Display.	Closes the exam images and returns to the Worklist tab.
	Full Screen	Turns off the menus and standard toolbar so the image displays in the full viewing area. The View Exam toolbar is displayed.
	Image Panel Properties	Changes the display layout, image layout method, presentation rules, and cursor tracking style.
	Intensity Plot	Shows pixel intensity over time.
	Invert	Shows the negative of the image.
	Mag Box	Magnifies a portion of the image. This is the default setting in the Image per Square display mode.

	Magnify	Magnifies the entire image.
	Measure Annotation	Displays a line (in centimeters) or an angle (in degrees) drawn over the image.
	Show/Hide Montage	Switches between showing and hiding the montage.
	Mark Read. Display Next Exam	Marks the exam Read and displays the next exam on the worklist for reading.
	Next Panel	Displays the next panel for all exams being viewed. Not available for mammograms.
	Next Panel	<i>In Image-per-Square mode only.</i> Displays the next panel for the exam being viewed.
	Next Series	<i>In Image-per-Square mode only.</i> Displays the next series for the exam being viewed.
	Number	Places a number on the image in a specific location.
	Page Plane	<i>In Series per Square mode only.</i> Pages through and synchronizes multiple series that contain the same field of view.
	Page Through Series	<i>In Series-per-Square mode only.</i> Pages through a stack of images in a series.
	Presentation States	Displays Presentation States
	Previous Panel	Displays the previous panel for all exams being viewed. Not available for mammograms.
	Previous Panel	<i>In Image-per-Square mode only.</i> Displays the previous panel for the exam being viewed.
	Previous Series	<i>In Image-per-Square mode only.</i> Displays the previous series for the exam being viewed.
	Roam	Displays an area within the image, when the image is larger than the viewing window. You can move this viewing area across the image.
	ROI	Marks a region of interest (ROI) by inserting a pre-selected shape or by drawing a shape.
	Rotate/Flip	Mirrors the image or rotates the image.

Button	Name	Action
	Scroll	In Image-per-Square mode only. Scrolls the images on the screen.
	Select and Drop	Copies a series or image to another cell. Works across panels to swap series between squares. Drop series 1 on series 2, series 1 is displayed where series 2 was, and series 2 is displayed where series 1 was.
	Send ID	Sends ID number.
	Set Image-per-Square display mode	A viewing mode that displays one image of a series in each viewing window.
	Set Series-per-Square display mode	A viewing mode that displays one series in each viewing window. One image in each series is visible at a time. The images in the series are stacked.

Button	Name	Action
	Shutter	Temporarily uses a rectangular or circular mask to block pixels outside the selected area. Used to shut out unwanted light.
	Skip to Next Exam	Opens the next exam on the worklist.
	Skip to Previous Exam	Opens the previous exam on the worklist.
	Smart Shuffle	<i>In mammography only.</i> Shuffles primary exam and comparison exam images.
	Thumbnail bar	Shows or hides the thumbnail bar.
	Text Annotation	Writes a text note on the image.
	Window/Level Image	Adjusts the contrast of the image.



4 Image Viewing Shortcuts

Keyboard shortcuts for image viewing

Press key	With this tool	To result in this action
Shift		Crop Immediately show a preview of the cropped image.
Up/Down arrow		Cine Change speed. Up arrow increases speed. Down arrow reduces speed.
Left/Right arrow		Cine Change direction. Left arrow changes to reverse. Right arrow changes to forward.
Alt+click or wheel click	[All]	All tools Change format to 1:1. Press Alt+click again to return to last format.
Ctrl		Page Through Series Enables DICOM position-linked scrolling. Release to turn off synchronized slice views.

Keyboard shortcuts to apply to whole series

- 1 Select the tool.
- 2 Move the pointer to the image.
- 3 Press the < or > key. The pointer shows the tool with an “A”.
Example:
- 4 Click the image to apply.

NOTE: When using the < and > shortcuts or the View menu option Apply to Whole Series, the system applies the imaging tool to all images in the series. This action may affect images that are not currently visible on the display.

After you press < or >, the tool continues to have an “A”, and applies the tool to the entire series. To turn off this feature, press < or > again.

Selecting and comparing images

To	Take this action
Scroll through images:	Click and hold the left mouse button, and move the mouse up or down. OR Press the Up arrow or Down arrow.
Display or hide thumbnails bar:	Press F11 .
Display another series:	Press Page Up or Page Down .
Compare exams:	Click the Compare button to display one or more previous exams for the same patient.
